

EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES IN USA



Every student faces a problem when it comes to overseas education. The ISC (DPS, Bopal) hosted the second U.S.A education fair in the campus with assistance of Ms. Kanya Suri. It was an interactive session with over 16 universities from all over the USA coming over to Delhi Public School, Bopal. Initially, the stage was open for all the welcomed delegates to guide the young minds and brief them about the importance of overseas education. After the introductory session, the hall was then open for them to put up stalls for their respective universities. Students, in groups, approached the esteemed guests and the floor was given to them for collecting information specific to the university and doubt solving. Every university had its own speciality.

The TROY University: The total number of students are approx 8000, it is a public university also a floor to state business. It also provides a PhD in sports management, computer sciences and liberal arts.

The ACADEMY OF ART UNIVERSITY [San Francisco], providing education to over 18000 students, it is the largest private art and design university in the whole USA. The campus now encompasses over 40 faculties in and around San Francisco; it also offers several undergraduate and graduate degree as well as non-degree programs. Stating all the facilities, it provides the best technology and is one of the best equipped Art and Design school in the nation, using only cutting edge, industry grade equipment and software.

The SUFFOLK UNIVERSITY which is a 100 yr old school located in Boston. It opens the door for students interested in Law, Arts and Sciences. There is also an access to various medical areas.

The FULL SAIL UNIVERSITY,FLORIDA , the classes are offered monthly, so a degree that would normally take 4 yrs would take 24 months on average . Unlike most US universities tuition is set for the duration of your program and doesn't rise from semester to semester. The programs start every month , so you don't need to wait for fall to begin your education.

The BUFFALO STATE, NEW YORK is the largest comprehensive master's – level university in The State University of New York (SUNY) system. With more than 300 international students from 54 different countries, Buffalo State's student body is rich with different cultures and perspective.

The OLD WESTBURY with national rankings and notable awards , it is a great location for study and internships i.e. in the prime location of New York. It also provides scholarship for visual arts, criminology , philosophy and religion, languages and business studies.

UNIVERSITY OF CINCINNATI which is the co-educational institution for English, Architecture design , Business-popular major. With scholarship up to \$5000 to full tuition/year. The next university is the R.I.T which comes in the top 5 universities in exam preparation and innovation it was also identified in the Technology Magazine.

The WINONA,USA which is a home to very strong under graduates , provides in-state tuition , scholarships 1:20 faculty ratio which means easy access to the teacher. Winona offers professional , experienced staff in the International Services Offices , an intensive orientation program , and a Cross-Cultural Outreach Program to connect you with the community.

SESSION FOR HIGHER EDUCATION IN CANADA

Mr. Keir Mclsaac, International Student Recruitment Officer, from Memorial University of Newfoundland, Canada conducted a session on 9/9/2015 for grade IX to XII students of International Student Cell at Delhi Public School, Bopal. He informed the students that there are four campuses with a very safe and enjoyable environment under the Memorial University.

He guided the students about the admission process, courses offered, provision of scholarship etc. in Memorial University of Newfoundland. He emphasized that specific subjects are required, but flexibility is offered in accordance to the curriculum. The courses offered are diverse and the programs are very interesting. He also briefed the students about the Universities which have an international reputation for academic excellence. He enlightened students with information about the various requirements and criteria to be fulfilled and looked into, before applying to the universities abroad. A brief description about the Applications and their fees, Transcripts, Tests (TOEFL, SAT, IELTS, etc.), Recommendation Letters, Portfolio, Financial Statement of Support (for F1 Visa process), etc was provided in the brief interactive session that lasted for about an hour.

An important area of focus was the fees and the criteria for getting acceptance by the various Universities. Students were informed that while majority of the good universities would require a SAT score, there are a couple of other universities which do not require the SAT, but would judge the student based on his/her academic performance in the 9th, 10th and 11th grade, participation in cultural or social activities, recommendation letters, leadership qualities, etc.

Students were guided through the various other related aspects of pursuing education in the Canadian Universities and recommended to personally research about the freedom of flexibility, guidelines and requirements of the universities they aim for, and narrow down the options accordingly.
