Electronic waste or e-waste is the term used to describe old, end-of-life electronic appliances such as computers, laptops, TVs, DVD players, mobile phones, mp3 players, etc., which have been disposed by their original users. E-waste contains highly toxic chemicals like lead, cadmium, mercury, beryllium and phosphor compounds which can lead to serious environmental and human health hazards.

Such items can often be refurbished or recycled which can prevent the environmental pollution and hence can protect lives. In a bid to curb the steep increase in the quantity of e-waste generated, the students of Delhi Public School-Bopal, Ahmedabad initiated E-waste drive from 18th December to 21st December
