Earth Hour @ DPS-Bopal

“Our connection to Earth and nature is undeniable: our planet's gain is everyone's gain”.

Earth hour is now one of the world's largest grassroots movements for the environment which was started by WWF and partners as a symbolic lights-out event in Sydney in 2007. The event is held annually encouraging individuals, communities, and businesses to turn off non-essential electric lights, for one hour.

Delhi Public School-Bopal observed Earth Hour for the twelfth consecutive year with an aim to tackle our planet's biggest environmental challenge. The Green Warriors organized a campaign by sending messages in their respective groups requesting everyone to switch off all the non-essential lights from 8:30 pm to 9:30 pm. Members of the DPS- Family including Green Warriors, Green Teachers and Admin staff joined the movement with great determination to contribute their bit towards the ailing planet.
