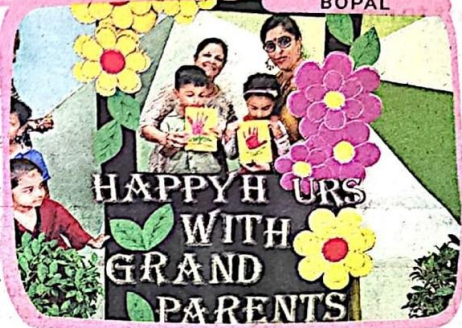
One of the most touching parts of the celebration was when the grandparents took the stage to share their thoughts, blessings, and words of wisdom. Their heartfelt messages reflected the depth
