Aashvi Singh, a student of class V at Delhi Public School, Bopal is an emerging young chess talent from Gujarat, having distinguished herself in both state-level and national-level

competitions. She developed an interest in chess at the age of six and soon began achieving notable success. In 2022, Aashvi won the Gujarat State Chess Championship in the Under-7 category for both National and Interschool games.

She has consistently delivered strong performances in various state chess tournaments across Gujarat, reflecting her active and successful presence on the competitive circuit. In 2024,

Aashvi secured the Gujarat State Champion title in the Under-9 category for both National and Interschool games, and in 2025 she finished as the run-

ner-up in the Under-11 State

Championship. Her participation in several FIDE-rated tournaments has resulted in first place finishes in her respective age categories, highlighting her strategic ability and competitive determination.

Aashvi has represented Gujarat at six national-level championships across the Under-7, Under-9, and Under-11 categories, achieving an impressive highest national ranking of 11. In January 2026, she clinched the champion title at the Gujarat State Under-11 Girls Chess Championship during the Khel Mahakumbh, organized by the Sports Authority of Gujarat in Ahmedabad. She was also the winner of the Khel Mahakumbh Mahanagar Palika Under-11 Girls event in 2024.

At just around ten years of age, Aashvi Singh's accomplishments mark her as one of the most promising young chess players in Gujarat, with strong potential for future national and international success.
