Furthermore, Sahaj Parikh and Vansh Thakor from Class 11 Science at Hill Woods School won the First prize in Inquisitive Innovators for their Dynamic Traffic Management System, which adjusts traffic signals automatically based on vehicle detection. Additionally, approximately 5 students were nominated for the INSPIRE Awards in the Idea/Innovation category.
