DPS-BOPAL: OVERALL CHAMPIONS OF KALFEST 2025!

Outstanding Performance at KALFEST 2025

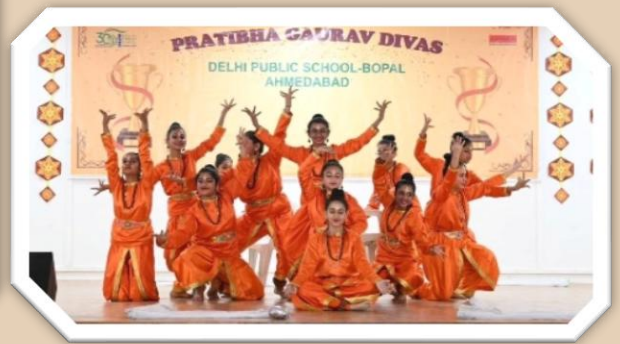

Pratibha Gaurav Divas: Celebrating Excellence and Forgiveness

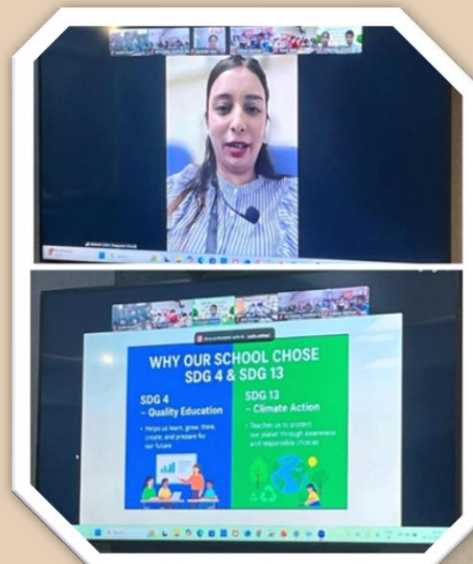
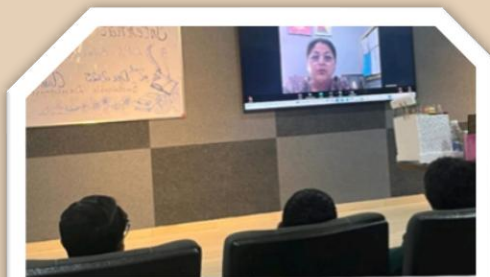

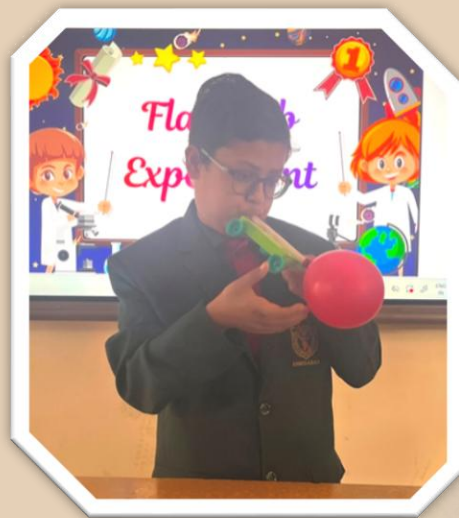


Serenade of Colours: Celebrating Indian Art

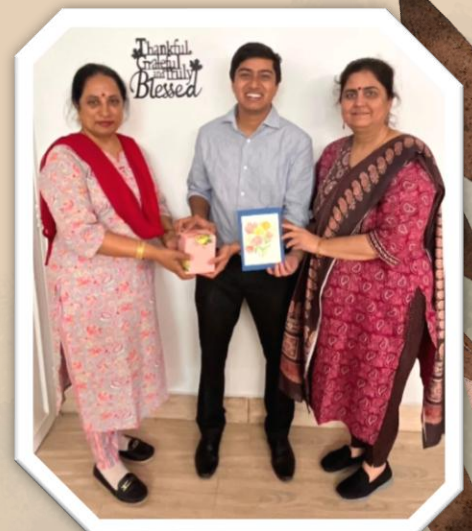
A Proud Milestone: Graduation Day

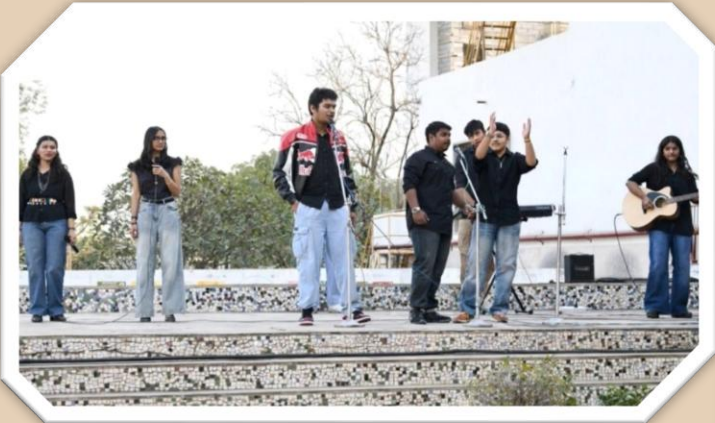

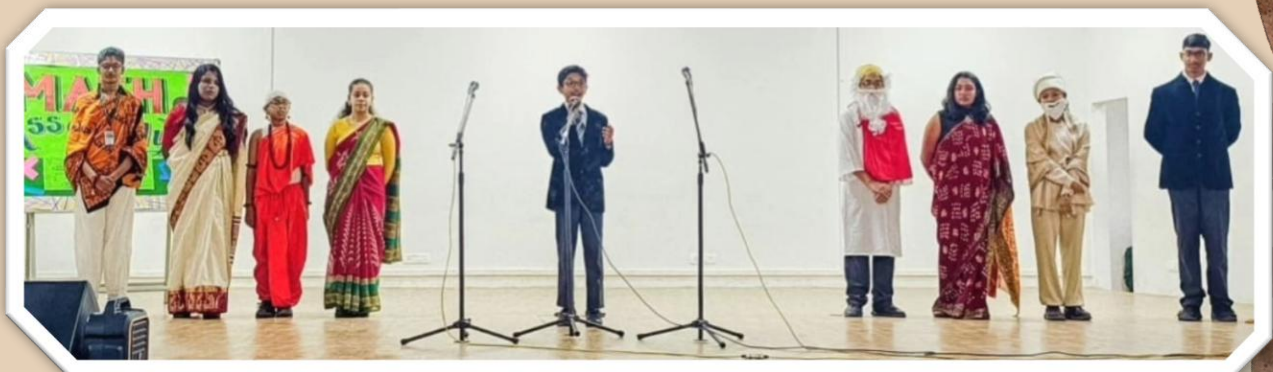
Let Your Dreams Take Flight

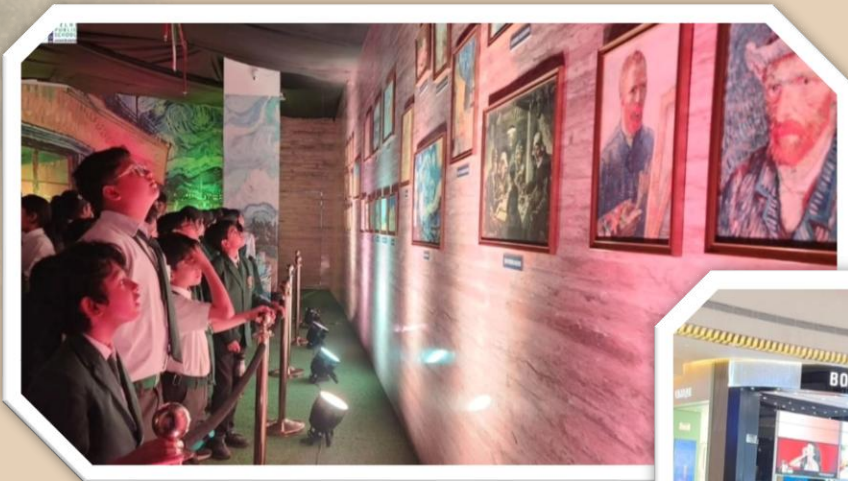
Adventure and Amusement at Adventure, Learning, and Lasting Bonds

भारत की बहुभाषी संस्कृति

एक भारत, अनेक भाषाएँ

मेरा नाम रिया है। मैं 9 साल की हूँ और मैं Delhi Public School, अहमदाबाद में पढ़ती हूँ। मुझे अपने स्कूल से बहुत प्यार है, क्योंकि यहाँ मुझे रोज कुछ नया सीखने को मिलता है।

एक दिन हमारी क्लास में एक नई लड़की आई। उसका नाम श्रीनिधि था। वह बहुत प्यारी थी और उसके बाल दो चोटी में बंधे थे। मैम ने उसे मेरे पास बैठाया। मैं बहुत खुश हुई क्योंकि मुझे नई फ्रेंड मिल गई।

लंच टाइम में मुझे प्यास लगी थी। तभी श्रीनिधि ने मेरी तरफ देखकर कहा,
“तन्नी कोडु...”

मैं उसे देखती रह गई। मुझे बिल्कुल समझ नहीं आया कि वह क्या बोल रही है। मैंने सोचा शायद वह कुछ पूछ रही है। फिर उसने हाथ से गिलास पीने जैसा इशारा किया। तब मुझे समझ आया कि उसे पानी चाहिए।

मैंने तुरंत अपनी बोतल उसे दे दी। उसने मुस्कुराकर “थैंक यू” कहा।

मैंने उससे पूछा, “तुम कौन सी लैंग्वेज बोल रही थी?”

वह बोली, “मैं श्रीनिधि हूँ। मैं Chennai से आई हूँ। वह Tamil Nadu में है। वहाँ हम लोग तमिल बोलते हैं।”

मैं बहुत हैरान हो गई। मुझे लगा इंडिया में तो सब हिंदी, गुजराती और इंग्लिश ही बोलते हैं। मुझे बहुत इंटरेस्ट आया।

मैम ने एक गुजराती कहावत भी बताई – “बार गाऊ ए बोली बदलाया” इसका मतलब है कि थोड़ी-थोड़ी दूरी पर बोलने का तरीका बदल जाता है। मतलब सिर्फ राज्य ही नहीं, बल्कि एक ही राज्य में भी अलग-अलग जगह पर भाषा का स्टाइल बदल जाता है।

फिर मैम ने कहा, “हमारी राष्ट्रभाषा हिंदी हमें जोड़ने का काम करती है। अगर हम अलग-अलग भाषाएँ बोलते हैं, तो भी हिंदी से हम एक-दूसरे को समझ सकते हैं। इस तरह पूरा भारत एक परिवार जैसा है।”

मुझे बहुत अच्छा लगा।

तब मैंने हाथ उठाकर कहा, “मैम, अब तो AI भी आ गया है। उससे हम एक-दूसरे की भाषा जल्दी समझ सकते हैं। लेकिन फिर भी हम अपनी भाषा को बचाकर रख सकते हैं।”

मैम मुझे देखकर मुस्कराईं और बोलीं, “वाह रिया! तुमने बहुत अच्छी बात कही। टेक्नोलॉजी हमें जोड़ सकती है, लेकिन अपनी भाषा और संस्कृति को संभालकर रखना हमारी जिम्मेदारी है।”

श्रीनिधि भी खुश होकर मुझे देख रही थी।

उस दिन के बाद मैंने और श्रीनिधि ने एक प्रॉमिस किया। हमने कहा कि हम एक-दूसरे को अपनी-अपनी भाषा सिखाएंगे।

वह मुझे तमिल के छोटे-छोटे शब्द सिखाती थी, जैसे “वणक्कम” मतलब नमस्ते। और मैं उसे गुजराती सिखाती थी, जैसे “केम छो?” मतलब कैसे हो?

तीन महीने बाद एक दिन मैंने उसे तमिल में पूछा, “नींगा एपड़ी इरुकींगा?” मतलब आज आप कैसी हो?

श्रीनिधि पहले तो चौंक गई, फिर हँसकर बोली, “मजामा!”

पूरी क्लास हँस पड़ी और सबने ताली बजाई। मैम भी बहुत खुश हुईं।

उस दिन मुझे समझ आया कि अलग-अलग भाषा होना कोई प्रॉब्लम नहीं है। बल्कि यह तो बहुत सुंदर बात है। हर भाषा एक फूल की तरह है और भारत एक बड़ा सा गार्डन है।

अब मैं जब भी किसी को अलग भाषा में बोलते सुनती हूँ, तो मुझे अच्छा लगता है। क्योंकि मुझे पता है कि भारत की यही असली खूबसूरती है – हमारी बहुभाषी संस्कृति।

मुझे अपने देश पर बहुत गर्व है।
